World Host – Draft communication plan in progress.

Craigellachie Bridge – 200 years celebration in November. This is being led by the community council with MEP support where required.

Moray Business Week – Being held 10th to 14th of November. This will focus on the stage businesses face after initial set up. DM helping Highland Gateway develop a Moray focus.

Moray Christmas campaign in development.

DM is also working on a piece on Atos and their recent recruitment of apprentices.

Each Programme Manager to send DM two stories a month.

DM to check with Leigh Shanks, Highlands and Islands Enterprise that area profile information is up to date.

5) Update from Programme Groups

Transportation - SC

A95 Craigellachie to Aviemore – Jacobs Consultancy have been commissioned to undertake a study which will determine the economic and operational benefits of improving parts of the A95 and identify the work required to gain maximum benefits from relatively low cost improvements.

A96 Phasing Strategy – JG to speak to James Johnston, Strategic Business Forum, to gain views from the business community regarding this.

New Transportation Manager, Nicola Moss, starting work mid-September.

Developments at Buckie Harbour – The masterplan has been commissioned and looks to be completed by the end of October. A bid for a Community Asset Transfer has been placed for the Buckie Drifter building.

Development - JG

The Consultants' Report on The Elgin City Centre Masterplan: Charrette jointly funded by Moray Council and Scottish Government, is now completed. If approved, another Charrette will take place next year. Future workshops will be held on the vision for the Elgin Town Hall and the Cooper Park.

Tourism and Culture Group - AA

Culture Strategy being finalised for presentation to MEP.

Laich of Moray project – Draft Development Plan in place which formulates an approach towards a long term aim of seeking the designation, by UNESCO, as a World Heritage cultural landscape. Aim to create formal body to take forward the project, from the present steering group. Academic authentication also in progress.

World Host - People1st's funding bid to the Scottish Government has been approved. Flexible Training Opportunities (FTOs), from Skills Development Scotland, now open for application. Saltaire Security Ltd putting 20 of their staff through the training over two days in September. Historic Scotland are also looking to have six of their employees trained. AA attending workshop in Inverness hosted by People1st for the pilot areas on the 4th and 5th of September. A workshop will also be held for all trainers in the area.

Inward Investment and Business Growth - SH

Forres Enterprise Park – Positioning paper on next phase of developments to be presented to the HIE Leadership team. A review of enquiries in the last year shows that there were 23 enquiries, 5 of which lead to leases.

Inward Investment material – Looking to develop more material around the quality of life.

Buckie Harbour – Masterplan commissioned, report should be completed in eight weeks.
