Integrated Resource Framework

The group received a presentation on Integrated Resource Framework (IRF) from Alan Sharp and Chris McCluskey from NHS Grampian. The IRF is a project initiated by the Scottish Government that all NHS boards in Scotland are undertaking. It seeks to map resource usage back to defined populations using health (NHS) and social care (local authority) spend so that variations can be identified and investigated.
